H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Wednesday, May 27, 2015)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Tuesday, May 26, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Awarded the Monthly Volunteer Recognition Award to Mr. James Willson, for his volunteer services at the Sulphur Creek Nature Center.
- Accepted the low qualified bid of \$2,061,000 submitted by Suarez and Munoz Construction, Inc. of Hayward.
- Accepted the low qualified bid of \$9,950 submitted by First Serve Productions, Inc. of Danville, for the Mt. Eden Tennis Court Resurfacing.
- Approved Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$17,170 for the HVAC Upgrades at San Felipe Community Park.
- Authorized disposal of Surplus vehicle, 2007 Ford Ranger Truck Supercab 4x2, which has been deemed surplus and no longer usable or serviceable.
- Appointed Mr. Vince Vierra to the position of Maintenance and Construction Foreman at a starting salary of \$6,791 monthly, \$81,492 annually, effective June 1, 2015.
- Appointed Ms. Carrie Godchaux to the position of Custodial Supervisor in the Recreation Department at a monthly salary of \$5,698 per month or \$68,376 annually, effective June 1, 2015.
- Appointed Vice President Minane Jameson as the Board representative to the Hayward Area Recreation and Park Foundation Executive Committee, effective immediately.
- The next meeting of the Board of Directors will be held on Monday, June 8, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., at the District Administration Office.
