## **H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING** *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Tuesday, August 11, 2015)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, August 10, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Accepted low qualifying bid of \$10,874,000 submitted by D.L. Falk Construction, Inc. of Hayward, and award of contract contingent upon receiving Performance and Payment Bonds for required specialized inspection services related to the Phase I Renovation of the San Lorenzo Community Park.
- Rejected a claim received from Ms. Tori D. Chea on behalf of Ms. Chea and her minor son, Bunma Chea, Jr. regarding alleged personal injury, under the provisions of Government Code Section 912.6, and directed Staff to notify Claimant, District Legal Counsel, and Insurance Broker.
- Authorized the General Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with VenueTech Management Group of Lafayette, CA for recommendations of Future Operations of the Douglas Morrisson Theatre at a cost not to exceed \$25,000.
- Adopted a resolution requesting a tax advance from Alameda County in the amount of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in order to meet the District's financial obligations and cash flow needs.
- Approved the naming of the section of the San Francisco Bay Trail, Hayward Regional Shoreline the Bill Lockyer Trail in honor of Mr. William Westwood "Bill" Lockyer.
- Adjourned the meeting in honor and memory of Recreation Coordinator Terry Sullivan's mother, Mrs. Marilyn Sullivan, who passed away on Monday, July 27, 2015.
