- If your child uses an inhaler, please be sure to bring the inhaler every day of camp. He/she will not be able to attend camp with out it.
- **ATTENTION DRIVERS:** Please try to use the parking lot Monday morning. If parking on the street, please be considerate of the neighbors and avoid blocking driveways or damaging landscapes, as cars may be towed.
- If your child is prone to "accidents", please send them to camp with an extra set of shorts or pants.
- Please come with emergency contact information for child. We will provide you with the required forms upon your arrival.
- The Directors place the children in camper groups by age. Please do not request specific groups for your child.

On Monday morning of your camper's registration, the Director of Camp Tenderfoot will greet you and provide you with a more specific weekly schedule. Please feel free to address any concerns or questions with the Director at that time.
