H.A.R.D. BOARD OF DIRECTORS' BI-MONTHLY MEETING *Actions and Calendar of Upcoming Events*

Hayward, CA (Tuesday, July 28, 2015)

The Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (H.A.R.D.) conducted its Board of Directors' meeting on Monday, July 27, 2015. The following action was taken:

- Awarded the Monthly Volunteer Recognition Award for June 2015 to Ms. Laura Stull for her volunteer service in the Special Needs Program.
- Adopted a Resolution accepting the closing figures for the 2014/2015 Fiscal Year Budget.
- Adopted a Resolution approving the Fiscal Year 2015/2016 Budget, including Staff's recommended changes.
- Accepted low qualifying bid of \$1,239,995 from ICC General Contractors, Inc., and award of contract contingent upon receiving Performance and Payment Bonds for required specialized inspection services related to the renovation of the Castro Valley Swim Center.
- Authorized Staff to enter into a professional services agreement with A Plus Project Inspection Services for 88 days based on a 4 hour minimum charge at a total cost not to exceed \$30,000 for the renovation of the Castro Valley Swim Center.
- Authorized Staff to enter into a professional services agreement with Vanir Construction Management, Inc. to perform project management services for the Phase I Renovation project at San Lorenzo Community Park at a cost not to exceed \$329,814.
- Authorized Staff to extend the Real Property License Agreement with Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District for a period of ten (10) years, commencing July 15, 2015, and terminating on July 14, 2025, under the existing terms and conditions of the agreement.
- Adopted the Amended Ordinance No. 001-02 pertaining to the Regulations Governing Use of Parks, Recreation Areas and Facilities and authorized the publication of the Ordinance Summary.
- Appointed Ms. Elizabeth Renteria to the position of Public Information Assistant at a starting salary of \$4,651 monthly, \$55,812 annually, effective August 1, 2015.
- Appointed Mr. Darrell Jones to the position of Golf Course Caretaker at a starting salary of \$5,443 monthly, \$65,316 annually, effective August 1, 2015.
