- Authorized General Manager to Execute a Memorandum of Understanding for the Phase I Governance of the Hayward Youth and Family Services Center.
- Authorized General Manager to enter into an agreement with CliffordMoss for an amount of \$6,000 per month plus approved business expenses to provide strategic consulting services.
